

Venom - Introduction



The Nostalgia Fuel Altered Association (NFAA) (<u>www.nfaa.info</u>) was formed to encourage old school Fuel Altered cars to race, which up to this point had no official classification and therefore could not compete. The Nostalgia Fuel Altered cars brought something new and exciting to the already popular drag race events, being older looking cars accelerating from a standing start to 100mph in less than 1 second, something that needs to be seen to be believed!

There have been a number of cars that represent Venom Racing, ranging from the Model T Ford to the current car, a classic 1971 Chevrolet Camaro.


1927 Model T Ford on nitro broke many NFAA records



Anatomy of a Funny Car

CHASSIS: With a required wheel base of 124 to 125 inches, a Funny Car chassis is made from about 200 feet of 4130 chromoly tubing. Standard features include front spindles, a steering box, seat, floor pan, motor plates, rear end plates, Fuel tank, all handles, clutch pedal fuel shut-off and parachute release levers, controls cables, oil overflow tank, roll bar pads and a finished body.

SUPERCHARGER: Mounted on top of the intake manifold on the engine, this belt driven mechanical device forces air into the engine.

BRAKES: The four-wheel disc brakes are activated with a hand lever in the cockpit. The primary braking system is a pair of independently mounted parachutes. BODY: The body must be a 2000 or later model. A standard body is stretched and lengthened to the desired specifications. Bodies must be removable from the rear using a pull handle release mechanism.

TYRES & WHEELS: The tyres on the rear are 18 inches wide and nearly 10 feet in circumference. The air pressure is at 6 pounds. The front tyres have a minimum wheel diameter of 17 inches. All four tyres must bear the same manufacturer's brand name and must meet size requirements. ENGINE: The engine of choice is an aluminium version of the famed 426 Chrysler Hemi V8.

WINGS: Per NHRA rules, the rear spoiler must be mounted to but not built into the body. Made of aluminium, magnesium or carbon fibre, they apply down force to the rear tyres.

> FUEL: The powerful fuel that is used in a Funny car is nitromethane, produced by the nitration of propane. Fed by two pumps that can each deliver more then 100 gallons per minute. A typical Funny Car will consume 15 gallons of nitro during a burnout, staging and full pass. Nitro content cannot exceed 90 percent, the remaining 10% being methanol.
